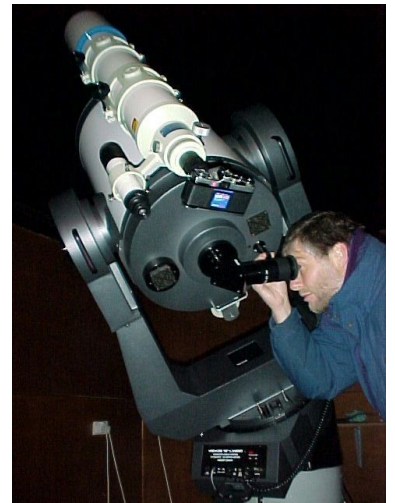
Visitors are welcome at Guernsey's

The Observatory is in La Rue du Lorier, St Pierre-du-Bois. Perry's Guide reference 21 E3.

Parking is usually available at La Houquette School, Rue des Paysans. From the school, follow the signs: go 100 yards up the road, then left onto Rue du Lorier, then immediately right, behind a large bunker. The road is dark, so a torch and high-visibility clothing are advisable.
